The Optomap is fast, easy, and comfortable for patients and may make pupil dilation unnecessary in many cases. Patients are able to resume contact lens wear immediately after their examination.

Your doctor will review the results of your Optomap images with you during your examination in a few moments.

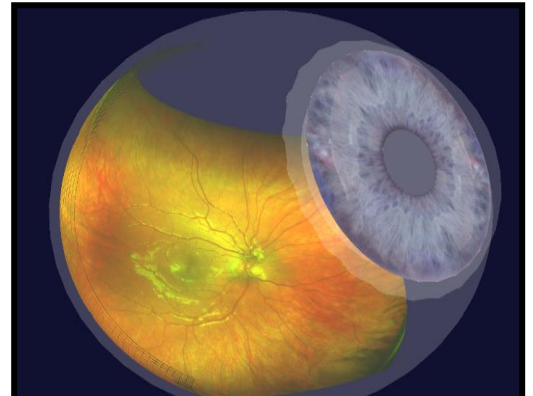
